



Waterkloof to launch debut Platter's 5-star wine at Intrepid SA

Waterkloof, the independent, Demeter certified biodynamic farm overlooking False Bay will launch their debut Platter's 5-star wine for the first time on the international stage at Intrepid SA. Not only is Circle of Life White 2013 the first 5-star award for Waterkloof, but 2013 was also Cellar Master Nadia Barnard's first vintage at the helm.

Circle of Life tells the story of Waterkloof: a conventionally farmed vineyard with vast, untapped potential which, over ten years, was transformed into a living, breathing, biodynamic farm that is now revealing its true self in the wines. In terms of flavour and character, the two wines in this range - Circle of Life Red and Circle of Life White - are neither defined solely by grape varietals, nor indeed a specific block within the vineyard, but instead encapsulate the myriad soils, aspects, altitudes and grape varieties found on their spectacular, ocean-facing farm.
