#### **CHENIN BLANC**

Whether crafted as zesty, unoaked wines or elegantly aged in barrel, South African Chenin Blanc consistently demonstrates the synergy between terroir and winemaker. This diversity underscores Chenin's role as the cornerstone of South Africa's wine identity.

#### **PINOTAGE**

Pinotage is a unique red wine grape variety that is native to South Africa, where it was first cultivated in 1925. It was created by crossing Pinot Noir and Cinsault (the latter was historically called Hermitage in South Africa, which explains the name "Pinotage"). Pinotage is a source of national pride in South Africa and is considered a building block of the country's wine heritage. It represents a uniquely South African cultivar and is a cornerstone of many winemaking regions, particularly in the Cape Winelands, such as Stellenbosch and Paarl.

#### **SHIRAZ**


The first Shiraz to be bottled with the cultivar name on the label was the 1957 vintage from Bellingham. This was made by Bernard Podlashuk who is known as the Father of South African Shiraz. Currently, Shiraz is the second most planted red grape variety in South Africa with 8,712 hectares under vine. It is also second in terms of red wine sold per cultivar. Shiraz can be found in all the wine growing regions of South Africa, producing a variety of styles from different terroirs. What is it in South Africa ... Syrah or Shiraz? Shiraz is generally produced in a more full-bodied, new world style, while Syrah is lighter, more elegant and fresher in the French/old world style. However, examples can be found in reverse under these names – there are no hard and fast rules.
