In the afternoon from 14:00 until 17:00, you will be able to get a glimpse into South African Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, Pinotage, Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon from Stellenbosch.

This platform aims to give visitors a glimpse into a small selection (120) of some of the best wines that are produced in South Africa from different producers, regions, along with different styles and price points – something for everyone. 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MERLOT

Merlot was first introduced to South Africa in the late 19th century, but it was only in 1969 when David van Velden of Overgaauw Wine Estate, Stellenbosch travelled to Bordeaux and noticed that premium Merlot was growing on soils with a similar clay content to his farm in South Africa. Overgaauw finally produced the first South Africa single varietal Merlot in 1982. Early South African plantings only amounted to about 81 hectares but have since expanded enormously to a current surface area of over 5,300 hectares. Merlot is currently the most widely drunk red wine variety in South Africa and has tremendous commercial value. South Africa exports approximately 10 million litres of Merlot every year.

OLD VINE RED VARIETIES

Wines made from old vines hold a special place in the wine world, reflecting the grower’s connection to the land. South Africa celebrates this legacy through the Old Vine Project, allowing producers to certify their vineyards as Certified Heritage Vineyards, complete with a seal on the bottle showcasing the vineyard’s planting date. South Africa’s vineyard plant dates are verified by the South African Wine Industry Information Systems’ (SAWIS) database, which extends back to 1900. Discover the brilliance of South African old vine red varieties like Cinsault, Grenache, and Pinotage.
